

## JABEE 2011 Examiner Training Seminar

JABEE 2011 Examiner Training Seminars were held twice on the following dates:

- One-day Seminar – August 20<sup>th</sup>, Sat. at AIJ Hall
- Two-day Seminar – August 27<sup>th</sup> -28<sup>th</sup>, Sat. & Sun. at Cross Wave MAKUHARI

For the one-day Seminar, 170 people in total comprising 86 examiners and 26 observers as well as 58 team chairs and vice-chairs, who couldn't attend the two-day Seminar, participated in the seminar. Also, 51 attendees including 40 team chairs participated in the two-day Seminar. The total attendees of one-day and two-day Seminars were 221. President of JABEE, Dr. Tsutomu KIMURA and 10 members from JABEE Criteria Committee and Coordinating Committee of Examination and Accreditation took role as lecturer.

The lectures of this year focused on “Outcomes Evaluation”, “Examination of Engineering Design Education” and “Relevancy of Criteria 1-3-5 and Judgment of Criteria 5(3), (4)”, which are important points to keep in mind at the scene of examination, received strong response from the attendees. These themes are not only topics JABEE puts emphasis on for examination and accreditation but also themes frequently being raised by the examiners and educational institutions. Furthermore, outcomes evaluation and engineering design education are more than just the matters of examination and accreditation but fundamental in order to encourage engineering education and to ensure international equivalency. JABEE plans to organize workshops under these topics in the future.

In the group work sessions programmed in the two-day Seminar, JABEE asked some of the attendees to volunteer the group leaders and rapporteurs for each group. As a result, it was a successful and meaningful all-hands type seminars.
