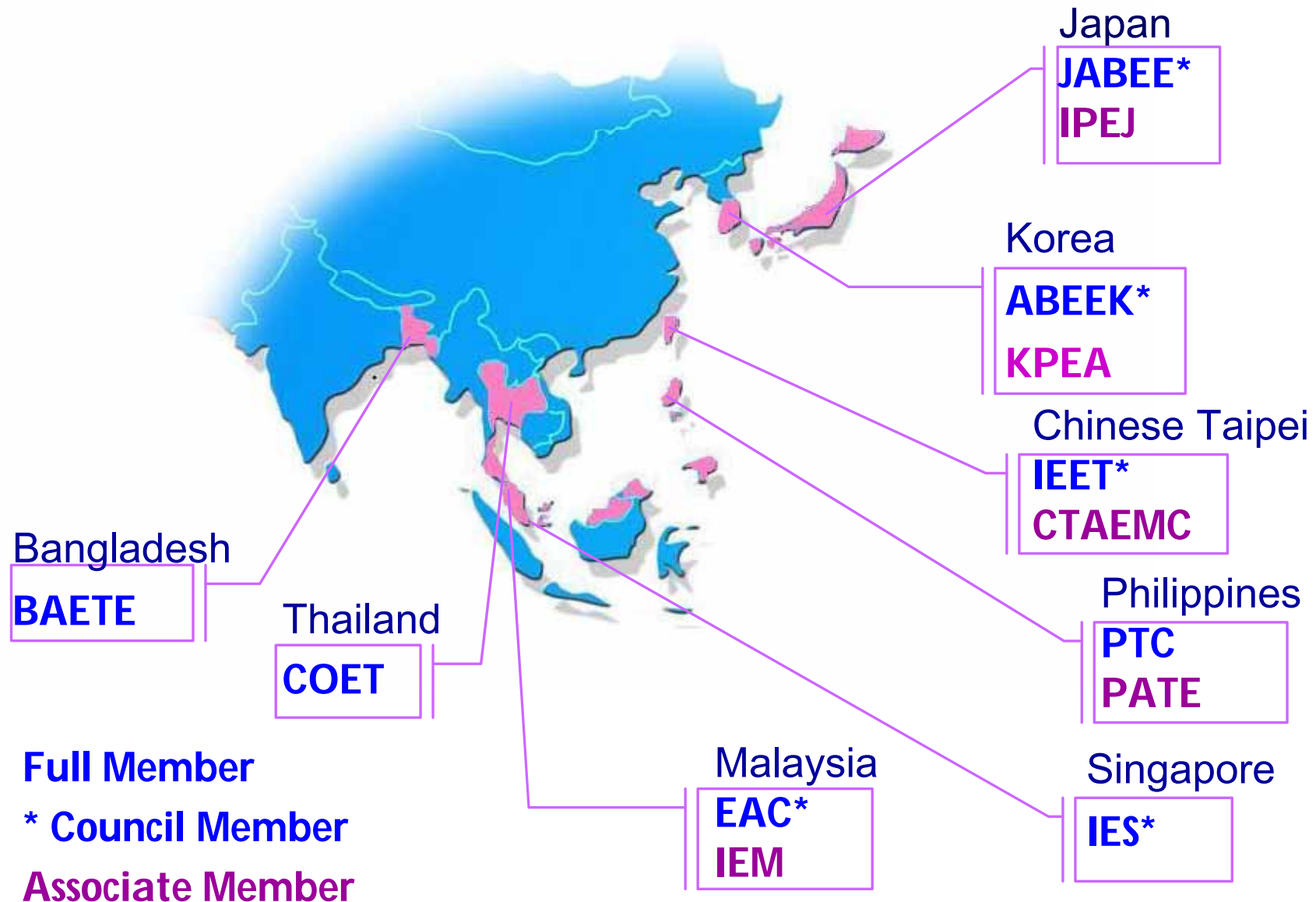

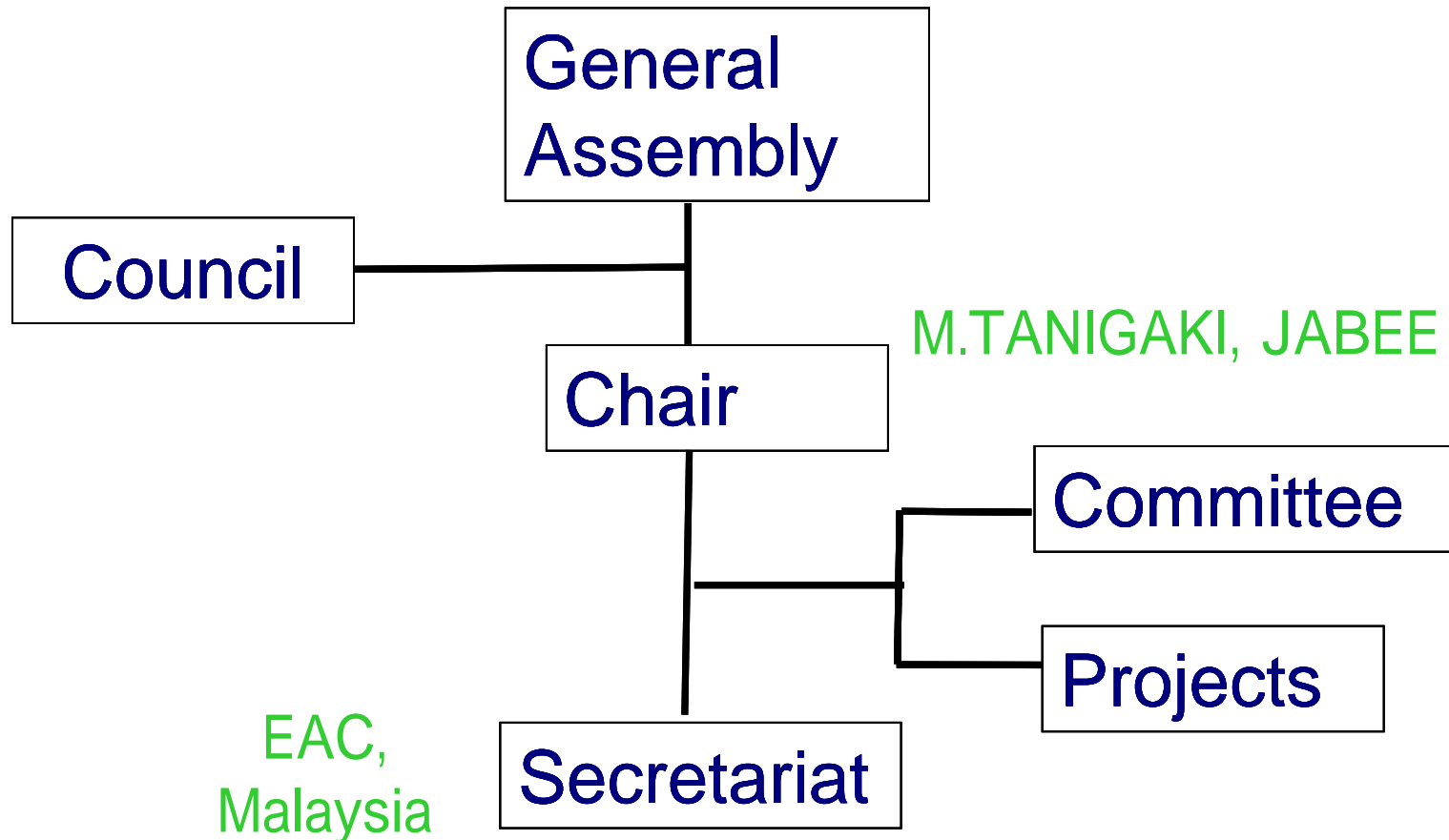
The goal of NABEEA, as a loose network, is to exchange information of the engineering education and the accreditation system among the countries/economies in Asia (level I), identification of the similarities and dissimilarities (level II), and to seek for the harmonization of the accreditation systems (level III). As a natural consequence of this activity, we may come to the point where we feel some kind of stronger agreement of substantial equivalency is desirable (level IV). We then will go further to start a new agreement or accord, in which each member will assure the mutual equivalency of the engineering education.
